

**ASHBROOKE OWNERS ASSOCIATION
TRASH RECEPTACLE REGULATION
EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 2013**

At the October 9, 2013 meeting of the Board of Directors of the Ashbrooke Owners Association, the herein detailed regulation was passed regarding the storage of trash receptacles within Ashbrooke Subdivision.

Authority for the adoption of this regulation is as granted by the Ashbrooke DECLARATION OF COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS, ARTICLE XII, RULE MAKING. Said Covenants are recorded at the Office of the Chancery Clerk of Madison County, Mississippi at Book 2980, Pages 857 – 920.

THEREFORE, the following regulation is properly adopted and determined to be valid and enforceable on or after November 1, 2013.

All trash/garbage and recyclable receptacles and/or containers must be stored so as to not be visible from other lots, common areas, or public areas within Ashbrooke Subdivision on any day of the week other than on trash/garbage or recyclable collection days. All trash/garbage left on the curb for pickup on collection days must be kept enclosed in trash/garbage receptacles and/or containers at all times. After the trash/garbage is picked up, all trash/garbage receptacles and/or containers must be returned to their storage areas on the same day of collection. This regulation also applies to recyclable material receptacles and/or containers.

The provisions of this Regulation shall be enforceable in the same manner as are the provisions of the Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for Ashbrooke referenced above, and by the Ashbrooke Owners Association Procedure for Enforcement of Covenants.
