## Ashbrooke ARC Fence Requirements

All fences constructed in Ashbrooke shall be "Good Neighbor Fences" constructed of cedar, treated pine, cypress, redwood, or any like material approved by the architectural committee. Fences shall not be taller than six (6) feet in height unless approved by the architectural committee. Stain, paint, sealer samples must be included for approval if fence is not left in its natural state.

Fences shall include:

- $4 \times 4$ or $6 \times 6$ posts beveled on top and set in concrete
- two or three stringers when using $2 \times 6$ 's or three stringers when using $2 \times 4$ 's
- $2 \times 4$ or $2 \times 6$ top cap (depending on post size and must be cedar or cypress only)
- $1 \times 6$ cedar pickets
- $1 \times 6$ cedar fascia board
